

NSCDA NEWS

An Unusual Biennial

The 63rd Biennial Council was unlike any other in the 130-year history of the NSCDA. The pandemic required our event to be virtual, and more Dames participated than had ever been possible before. The 15 educational sessions engaged over 850 Dames in learning more about our mission. With various topics including research with DNA, historic samplers and changing narratives at house museums, we came together, though physically apart. Keynote speaker David Rubenstein shared his concept of patriotic philanthropy and Professor Richard Bell spoke during the Arlington National Cemetery ceremony, encouraging us to better understand historical figures and their complex truths.

A highlight of the Biennial Weekend was the election and installation of our new Executive Committee and National President, Katherine Grainger Taylor Cammack. Honorary President Marcy Moody (2012 – 2016) and outgoing President Anna Duff (2016 – 2020) welcomed Katherine during an in-person ceremony in Florida. Katherine thanked her family and many Dames mentors, noting that they had taught her graciousness, generosity, and the value of participation. "We are an organization of strong, talented and selfless women. I stand on the shoulders of all the ladies who came before me in this position and across the National Society.... One hundred years from now, our history will show that in the midst of the pandemic of 2020, we launched the Great American Treasures Alliance, met virtually with 850 women, reopened National Headquarters Dumbarton House to visitors, and supported many projects around the country."

While the pandemic necessitated a temporary hiatus on travel, Dames enjoyed four successful "Evenings with Experts" with leading authorities like Dr. Michael Jarvis of the University of Rochester and Dr. John Morrow of the University of Georgia.

When Dames travel with the NSCDA, not only are they having a splendid time and enjoying the camaraderie of other Dames, but they're also contributing to the NSCDA. The 2020 Congressional Essay Contest winners were unable to travel to Washington due to COVID. We're proud of the almost 100 high school students involved and look forward to the resumption of this popular nationwide contest.

We look forward to announcing a new initiative in support of Service to the Military. This initiative, in accordance with our mission, impacts those who have served and are serving in the military. The Comprehensive Campaign \$10 Million Goal is Met!

Letter from Alexander Hamilton to Elizabeth Hamilton January 14, 1804

DUMBARTON HOUSE NEWS

Our Year in Summary

In 1928, the NSCDA searched for an early Federal house in Washington, D.C. to serve as its National Headquarters, and to "worthily illustrate the character and objects of the Society." The NSCDA identified Dumbarton House as the appropriate purchase, and this museum continues to be owned and stewarded by our members. The NSCDA established a National Archives and Museum Collection to illustrate the society's mission of preservation and history education for the public.

Dumbarton House offers our members tools to carry out our mission through best practices in preservation, education and collections management. The assets of the NSCDA headquarters provide each Corporate Society with initiatives to assist their properties, programs and collections. Dumbarton House also serves as a living history classroom for Washington-area students and adults.

This year, despite restrictions of the pandemic, we were able to continue some of our programs. Our first exhibit of the year, Pick your Poison, with guest curator Kelly Bresnowitz, had over 350 visitors. Discussion of the full spectrum of drink offered in our nation's capital 200 years ago was presented. Viewers learned about consumption of wine, beer, cider, tea, liquor, punch and chocolate by youth and adults, as was custom at the time, and about Thomas Jefferson's daily three glasses of wine.

Due to the COVID-19 restrictions and to meet safety requirements, National Headquarters Dumbarton House closed on March 13, 2020. Staff pivoted to a virtual reality and worked to create digital content that engaged NSCDA members, museum members and the public through online programming and social media. Once museum closures were initiated, all exhibits were transformed into digital resources and shared at DumbartonHouse.org. Not until November did we welcome guests back outdoors and with masks, when over 500 people attended Makers' Market in the garden. Featuring women-owned businesses from candy-makers to apparel designers to soap and candle vendors, the garden proved to be a safe and welcoming setting. Our partnership with Picnic Theater Company continued, and because of its virtual nature, viewers were welcomed from all over the world. This resulted in a \$21,500 donation to Dumbarton House in support of the educational programs we hold for D.C. schools. Of note, the Director's Talk brought museum professionals, Dames, and the public together to learn about the future of historic house museums in the aftermath of COVID. Over 150 participants joined this informative virtual

event, which can be streamed on the Dumbarton House YouTube page. Specially themed teas are regular on-site events at Dumbarton House, and Programs Manager Mary Lesher creatively pivoted to online entertaining. One of these events was featured on a San Antonio, Texas news station, where Diane Gottsman, a nationally renowned etiquette expert, encouraged viewers to register for our teas after she interviewed Mary.

Our staff reached out to museum neighbors to collect personal protective equipment (PPE) for donation to health care providers. We were thrilled to have Larz Anderson House, Heurich House Museum, Tudor Place Historic House and Garden, Woodrow Wilson House and Rebeca Kennedy of Curae Collections Care, LLC participate!

Partnering with our neighbor, Tudor Place Historic House and Garden, we produced a series of Museums 101 videos about the behind-the-scenes work at historic house museums. Viewers were treated to virtual lessons on archiving, conservation, and architecture.

The Garden Niche (North Garden, Dumbarton House)

Often photographed, this almost 100-yearold structure underwent preservation after we received a grant from the National Trust for Historic Preservation. The niche was designed in 1931 by Fiske Kimball (an architectural historian and former director of the Philadelphia Museum of Art) and constructed that year as part of the NSCDA's project to restore Dumbarton House to its original appearance.

Our Directors at Dumbarton House

We said our fond farewells to Karen Daly as she moved to Stratford Hall, where she will be the President of the 18th century Robert E. Lee family home and plantation. Over the past 15 years with the Dames, Karen implemented numerous successful programs, built the Dumbarton House staff, and led the NSCDA/Dumbarton House to new levels of achievement.

Dr. Laurie Ossman has been appointed as the interim Executive Director. A Brown University graduate, Dr. Ossman earned her Ph.D. in Architectural History from the University of Virginia. She has extensive experience working with cultural organizations and historic sites, including the Preservation Society of Newport County in Newport, Rhode Island, where she was the Director of Museum Affairs; The National Trust for Historic Preservation, where she was Director of Woodlawn Plantation; and Frank Lloyd Wright's Pope-Leighey House in Alexandria, Virginia. She has also served as Deputy Director of Vizcaya Museum and Gardens in Miami, Chief Curator of the Henry Morrison Flagler Museum in Palm Beach, and Restoration Project Manager for Cá d'Zan at the Ringling Museum in Sarasota, Florida.

Laurie is the author of several books for Rizzoli, including *Great Houses of the South*, *Carrere and Hastings* (with Heather Ewing) and *The Gentleman's Farm* (with Debra McClane), as well as a contributor to *The Smithsonian's History of America in 101 Objects* (Penguin, 2013) and numerous other publications.

Laurie is honored to be working with the NSCDA and Dumbarton House and is excited to participate in the special initiatives that make the efforts of the Dames so important.
